B.C. businesses can bid on certain contracts posted by state, regional, and municipal governments within the EU.



EU government procurement accounted for an annual market worth \$2.6 trillion (as of 2021).



CETA builds upon Canada's previous access to the EU under the World Trade Organization's Government Procurement Agreement.
